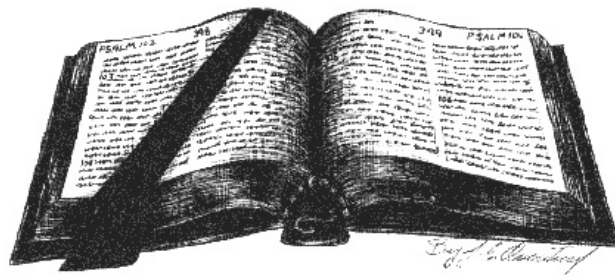




“In that day shall the deaf hear the words of the Book...”

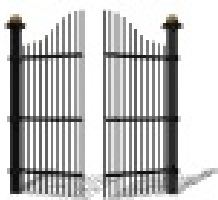
Isaiah 29:18

Imagine being able to hear the beautiful songs of the birds or the soft whisper of the wind in the trees; to be able to hear the little pitter patter of your child’s footsteps behind you, the laughter that comes from great happiness or the beautiful sound of angelic singing.



While here on earth you may never have your hearing but there can be a place and time where you can experience the joy of sounds all around you. God, who created you with His power and great love made a way possible for you to hear someday. “How can that be?” you ask, let me tell you how.

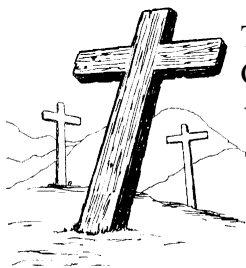


There is a place called Heaven where God will let you hear everything. God created Heaven. In Heaven everything is perfect. The Bible says in Revelation 21:4, “And God shall wipe away all tears from their eyes; and there shall be no more death, neither sorrow, nor crying, neither shall there be any more pain: **for the former things are passed away.**” In Heaven no one will be deaf. This is wonderful, but there is something you must do so you can go to Heaven.

You must believe that you are a sinner; that you were born a sinner. Psalm 51:7 says, ‘... in sin did my mother conceive me.’ The Bible says, “For all have sinned and come short of the glory of God”, Romans 3:23. Every person, deaf or hearing, is a sinner. Hearing people are not better than deaf people. Every person is the same.

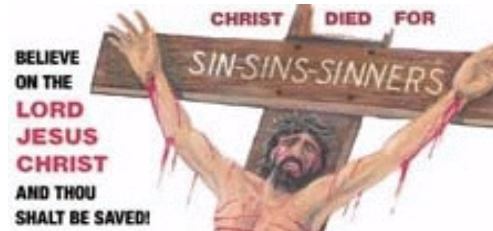
The Bible says we have **come short** of the glory of God. This means we have ‘missed the mark’, that no one has measured up to God’s standard of perfection except for Jesus, God’s Son.

I am sure deaf people like to play a game of darts. Let’s say you are playing the game and four of you have been given a dart to throw. One by one you do your very best to hit the target but you all miss the bull’s eye by inches. It does not matter how fast or good you threw: you ‘missed the mark’. People cannot go to Heaven because they live their lives doing good things. No one is worthy of Heaven. Ephesians 2:8,9 says, “For by grace are ye saved through faith; and **that not of yourselves:** it is the gift of God; not of works, lest any man should boast.”



The Bible says in Romans 6:23, “For the wages of sin is death but the gift of God is eternal life through Jesus Christ our Lord.” Because of your sins you will die one day and go to Hell if you do not confess them and accept God’s gift of eternal life. Sin makes people worthy of death. When people sin the payment is death and Hell, just like they receive a paycheck as payment for the work they do at their job.

Jesus, God’s Son, paid for your sins but not with money. Jesus died on the cross that your sins may be forgiven, that you might have eternal life. God loved you so much that He sent His only begotten Son (Jesus) into the world to die for you, John 3:16.

The Bible says in Acts 16:31, “...believe on the Lord Jesus Christ and thou shalt be saved,...” Romans 11:9 says, “That if thou shalt confess with thy mouth the Lord Jesus and shalt believe in thine heart that God hath raised Him from the dead, thou shalt be saved.”

We cannot trust in man to save us, only God can. Isaiah 45:22 says, “Look unto Me, (Jesus) and be ye saved, all the ends of the earth: for I am God, and there is none else.” How wonderful it would be if you would give yourself, body and soul to God, trusting in Him only for salvation from sin and death forever, knowing for sure that your sins have been forgiven.



I John 1:9 says, "If we confess our sins He (God) is faithful and just to forgive us our sins and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness." I John 5:13 says, "These things have I written unto you that ye may believe on the name of the Son of God; that ye may know that ye have eternal life, and that he may believe on the name of the Son of God."
